Functions:

- Identification of international research funding programmes, search for partners, and participation in international research forums, networks and decision bodies.
- Advice and support researchers in the preparation and submission of international competitive proposals as well as in all aspects of the granting process (approval, contract signature, budgets etc)
- Support in the presentation of proposals (work programme definition, provision of costs and time estimate, consortium building, assistance in proposal writing), direct contact with EU/International officers.
- Collaboration in the organization of infodays, training sessions for the scientific community etc.
- Communication with funding agencies and national contact points.
- Suport during the contract negotiation phase
- Fostering dissemination and communication activities related to the International projects

- BSc/MSc preferable in life sciences.
- Minimum 5 years of work experience in International Project Management (proposal writing and presentation) ideally in the health area (H2020, ERC, MSCA, USA NIH,..)
