The **Fundació Institut de Recerca de l'Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau** was created on June 4, 1992, is a scientific foundation whose mission is to promote basic, clinical, epidemiological and health services research in the field of health sciences and biomedicine, with the aim of contributing to the improvement of people's health and quality of life. Through the production and dissemination of scientific knowledge, the training of researchers of international level, the generation of health innovations, the application of advances to healthcare practice and health policies.

Located on the Sant Pau Campus, it is a biomedical research centre of excellence affiliated to the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) since 2009, and has been a centre of the CERCA system of Catalonia since 2011.

The Institute is made up of its own affiliated personnel who carry out their research in multidisciplinary groups of basic and clinical research, from the sister entities located on the Sant Pau campus and its surroundings. This means that it has also been recognized since 2011 as a high-level health research centre aimed at developing new techniques and processes through health innovation.

The Research Institute is one of the most active Catalan centres in the production of research work, especially in terms of translational research and the integration of new discoveries into healthcare practice.

In November 2018, the Institute signed its adherence to the CERCA Code of Conduct.

In 2020, the Institute signed the Charter of Commitment to Gender Equality in Research that was supported by 19 Catalan research and health canters and was read during the "Summit for the Advancement and Leadership of Women in Health Sciences", on October 22, 2019 in Girona.

- Studies of protein, mRNA and miRNA expression in human/animal biological samples aimed at identifying and characterizing the role of different receptors in inflammatory processes related to atherosclerotic pathology

PERMANENCE COMMITMENT: Selected persons who will hold the summoned or vacant position, will not be able to apply for a new call until 1-year period has expired. In case of part-time job positions, this period will be of 6 months. In both cases, the period will compute from the date of publication of the resolution. The vacant summoned, and the ones that derive from it (intern movements), will be successively covered on the same proceeding among the submitted candidates to each particular call, regardless of whether this entails coverage of places in turns other than the call.
