The Institute

The **Research Institute of Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau Foundation** (IR Sant Pau) is a scientific foundation whose mission is to improve the health and quality of life of the population through the production and dissemination of scientific knowledge, the international training of researchers, and the promotion of innovation and healthcare by incorporating medical advances into clinical practice and health policies. Founded in 1992, it has been a research excellence center affiliated with the Autonomous University of Barcelona (UAB) since 2009 and, since 2011, a CERCA center (Research Centres of Catalonia).

For the Foundation, it is a priority to ensure that the most suitable candidate is hired to fill a job through an open, transparent and merit-based selection process (OTM-R). Following these guidelines, staff mobility, knowledge exchange and, ultimately, the increase in the quality of teaching and research will be enhanced. Faithful to our commitment to the European Union's human resources strategy, our institution's personnel selection and recruitment procedures are governed by a set of basic principles that guarantee equal access to employability for all. About the Group:

The Sant Pau Research Institute has established the Advanced Therapies Unit to promote research in advanced therapies, increase manufacturing capacity under Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) standards, and facilitate the transfer of these therapies to patients.

The creation of this unit is strategic in providing research groups with the resources needed to develop advanced therapy projects, offer specialized services, and provide guidance to both public and private stakeholders. The unit currently operates a Clean Room facility and is involved in several active Advanced Therapy Medicinal Product (ATMP) projects, including academic clinical trials using CAR-T cells. It also features state-of-the-art facilities for the manufacture of these therapies under high-quality GMP standards, positioning the Institute at the forefront of this field in Europe. The successful candidate will report directly to the Technical Director of the facility.

Essential requirements

- Higher Education Degree (University Diploma, Bachelor's Degree, or equivalent qualification).
- Oral and written proficiency in Catalonia's two official languages, or alternatively, commitment to acquiring adequate proficiency in both languages within one year of appointment.
- Reading proficiency in English.
- User-level proficiency in office software tools (Excel, Word, PowerPoint, etc.).

Skills will be valued

- Knowledge and experience in Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP), particularly for Advanced Therapy Medicinal Products (ATMPs).
- Training and experience in cleanroom procedures for pharmaceutical manufacturing (personnel and material flows, disinfection procedures, etc.).
- Training and experience in Quality Management Systems.
- Analytical skills, teamwork, initiative, organizational abilities, and task prioritization skills.

Functions

- Environmental microbiological monitoring of classified areas, including sample collection and logistics management.
- Collection and processing of primary environmental monitoring data from classified areas.
- Receipt of materials and management of approval/rejection processes according to established procedures.
- Monitoring material inventories in warehouses and classified areas, including logistics management.
- Support in the operational management required to ensure compliance with maintenance, calibration, qualification, and equipment repair plans.
- Disinfection of manufacturing equipment.
- Order tracking and delivery note management.
- Duties related to the GMP Quality Management System, including drafting procedures, validation protocols, managing deviations/non-conformities, and related documentation.

- Annual working schedule of 1,627.5 hours (37.5 hours per week).

PERMANENCE COMMITMENT: *Selected persons who will hold the summoned or vacant position, will not be able to apply for a new call until 1-year period has expired. In case of part-time job positions, this period will be of 6 months. In both cases, the period will compute from the date of publication of the resolution. The vacant summoned, and the ones that derive from it (intern movements), will be successively covered on the same proceeding among the submitted candidates to each particular call, regardless of whether this entails coverage of places in turns other than the call.*
